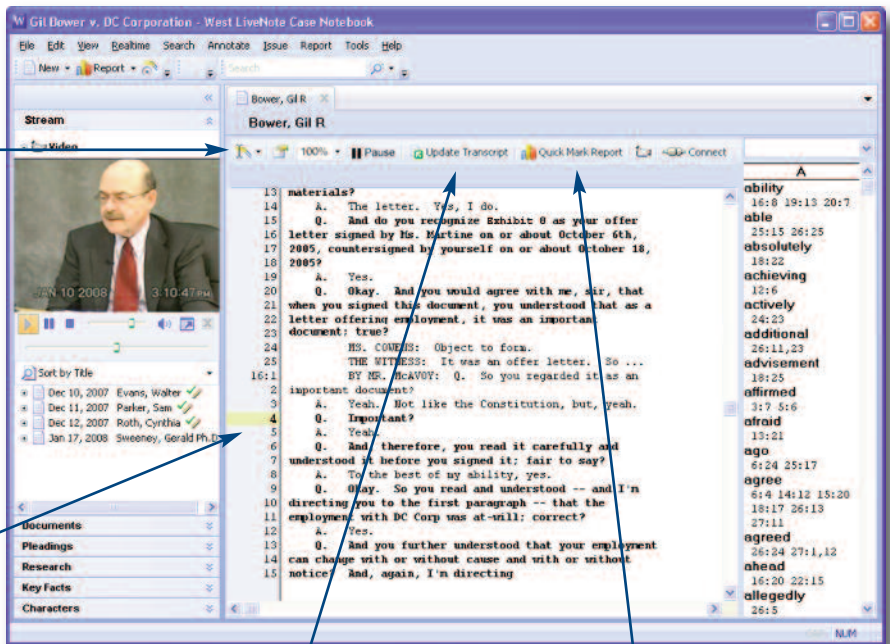
search previous depositions, and send conflicting passages to other connected team members via the Instant Messaging tool.
